One Undergraduate Program. Three Great Options.

- 1. Enroll in the Undergraduate Online Program after earning an Associate Degree
 - Take online classes at a reduced rate.
 - Complete a BSBA with concentrations in Accounting, General Business, Human Resources Management, Management, or Criminal Justice Management.
 - For some students, Federal and State grants and loans will leave zero out-of-pocket expense
 - Next steps: <u>Apply to Nichols</u> in the last semester of your Associate Degree Program
- 2. Enroll as a **full-time** <u>commuter</u> student after earning an Associate Degree
 - Enroll for a minimum of 12 credit hours each Fall and Spring semester
 - Students pay a reduced rate per semester.
 - Access the full catalog of Nichols programs and services: 19 majors and concentrations
 - For some students, Federal and State grants and loans will leave zero out-of-pocket expense
 - Next steps: <u>Apply to Nichols</u> in the last semester of your Associate Degree Program
- 3. Enroll as a **full-time** <u>resident</u> student after earning an Associate Degree
 - Enroll for a minimum of 12 credit hours each semester
 - The tuition, room and board rate are reduced by an ABLE scholarship
 - Access the full catalog of Nichols programs, as well as the convenience of on-campus living
 - For some students, Federal and State grants and loans will cover *most* of the remaining tuition, room and board expenses, leaving little out-of-pocket expense
 - *Next steps:* <u>Apply to Nichols</u> in the last semester of your Associate Degree Program
