What is Verification?

Your FAFSA application was selected by the US Department of Education for review in a process called "Verification". The Office of Financial Assistance must verify the information you reported on your FAFSA. If there are any differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected. The Financial Aid Office cannot make any federal financial aid payments available to you until all verification requirements have been met.

What Are the Steps?

- 1. Complete the IRS Data retrieval through the FAFSA (studentaid.gov).
- 2. If you cannot complete Step 1, you may order a TAX <u>**RETURN**</u> TRANSCRIPT from the Internal Revenue Service online at www.irs.gov, or by phone at 1-800-908-9946. Obtain a 2021 Federal IRS Tax Return Transcript for yourself and your parent(s), or submit a **signed** copy of the 2021 income tax return(s) and applicable schedules.
- 3. Complete and sign this worksheet you and at least one parent must sign.
