Payment Options


Nichols College accepts many forms of payment:

- E-Check/Credit: All electronic payments may be made on Nichols Self-Service. An E-check will withdraw directly from a bank account (routing and account number required). Credit/Debit transactions are assessed a convenience fee by the credit processor.
- Financial Aid/Loans: Your financial aid (grants and loans) will be listed under "Pending Financial Aid" on the statement
- Mail Checks to: Nichols College Student Accounts P.O. Box 5000 Dudley, MA 01570

Memo Section: Student ID#, payment term (2023FA for the Fall, 2024SP for the Spring), and the student name. If you are paying for multiple students, please mail one check per student.

Payments

Nichols College **does not** manage an official payment plan schedule. You can, however, make payments toward the student account balance. After the add/drop of the semester, any student with a balance over \$3,000 will have a registration hold applied to their account. This hold **does not** affect meal plans and students can continue to participate in classes, activities, sports, etc. This hold will only prevent class registration for the following semester. Registration holds are reviewed on a weekly basis and are removed once the balance is \$3,000 or less.
